1. Applications are invited for Ph.D. Programme in all areas of Chemistry in IIT Madras from candidates who have recently been awarded the CSIR-JRF, UGC-JRF or DST-INSPIRE.
2. Students currently in the last semester of their MSc / integrated BS-MS program are also encouraged to apply if they have CSIR-JRF or UGC-JRF.
3. Integrated BS-MS students from 'Centrally Funded Technical Institutes' (CFTI) (e.g. IISERs, NIT's etc), in the final semester and with CGPA of 8.0 and above until 6<sup>th</sup> semester can apply. If selected, they will be offered provisional admission to join in July 2019 session with MHRD funding support (HTRA). Final offer will be subject to fulfilling the required admission criteria at the end of MSc.
4. All the others who have valid GATE score and have a qualifying M. Sc. degree are invited to apply for the Interview session in May 2019 which will be announced later.

The selected candidates will be given a conditional offer, namely, the final admission to Ph.D. programme at IITM beginning August 2019 will be subject to their production of PG degree completion certificate/Mark list with minimum marks obtained (General 60%, OBC-NCL 54% and SC/ST/PwD 48%). The proof of having successful completion of PG degree in 2019 should be submitted within a period of one month following the declaration of PG results.
